Board Vacancy Announcement

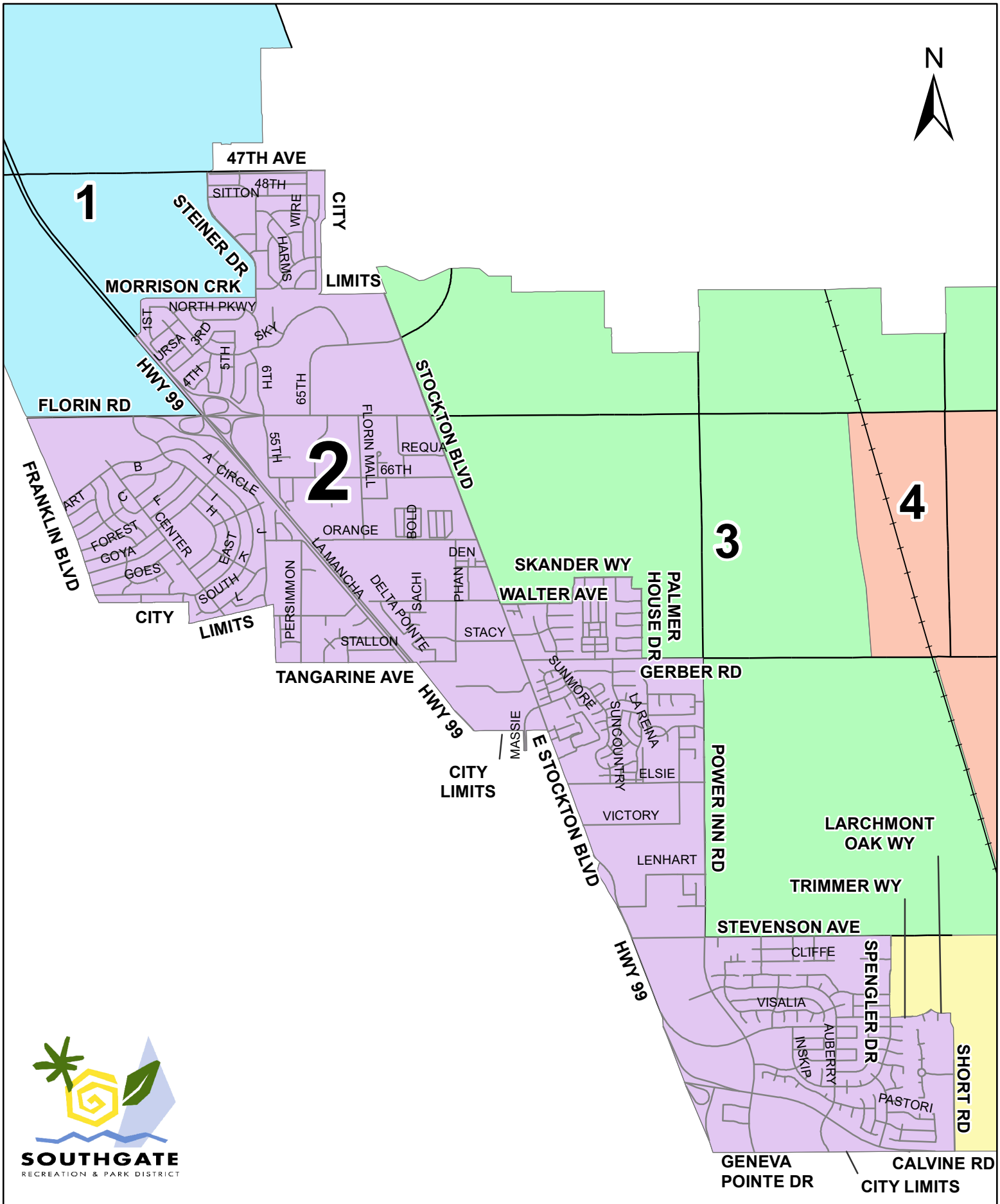
Sacramento, CA – The Southgate Recreation & Park District Board of Directors are accepting applications to fill by appointment, a vacancy on the Board. The appointment is to Division 2. Division 2 is outside City of Sacramento limits in the Nicholas, Parkway, Orange Park Cove and Countryside neighborhoods of unincorporated Sacramento County.

The northern division boundary is 47th Avenue between Steiner Drive and Sacramento city limits. The western boundary is Steiner Drive, corner of Steiner Drive and 47th Avenue, south to Morrison Creek, west along Morrison Creek, south on Morrison Creek to Highway 99, south along Highway 99 to Florin Road, west on Florin Road to Franklin Blvd., south along Franklin Blvd. to East Parkway, following the city limits east to Soules Way, continuing south along the city limits to Tangerine Avenue. The southern boundary extends from the city limits and Tangerine Avenue along Tangerine Avenue to Highway 99 and south on Highway 99 to just past Elder Creek then east on the other side of Highway 99 following the city limits to Stockton Blvd., south along Stockton Blvd to south along Highway 99 to Geneva Point Drive, east along Geneva Point Drive to Auberry Drive, east of Auberry Drive following the Elk Grove city limits which turns into Calvine Road to Short Road. The eastern boundary is north on Short Road across Tillotson Parkway to Crafton Court, west along Larchmont Oak Way to Trimmer Way, west on Trimmer Way, north on Spengler Drive to Stevenson Avenue, west along Stevenson Avenue to Power Inn Road, north on Power Inn Road to Gerber Road, west on Gerber Road to Palmer House Drive, north continuing on Palmer House Drive to Skander Way, west on Skander Way, south continuing along Walter Avenue to Stockton Blvd., north along Stockton Blvd. to city limit line near Patterson Way, west along city limits to Morrison Creek, north along the city limit line and Morrison Creek to 47th Avenue.

Persons wishing to be considered for this appointment must be a resident within the boundaries of Division 2. A map of the Division 2 boundaries is available at the District Office: 6000 Orange Avenue, Sacramento, CA 95823. Interested applicants must send a resume and a letter of interest addressed to the Board of Directors, c/o General Manager to the District Office. The letter shall specify the applicant's address, voter registration status, phone number and reasons why the applicant wishes to serve on the Board. Additionally, the applicant shall specify their involvement in the community, recreation and/or park services. The application deadline is April 9, 2024 at 3:00 p.m.
